


4 Installation

You can purchase a compatible parasol stand from FARE for the safe setup of the parasol. Please note the following information regarding the set-up of the parasol:

up of the parasol:

- Only use the parasol with a compatible parasol stand and adequate ballast.
→ Technical data
- The installation site must be level and firm. Maintain sufficient distance to heat sources and naked flames. Measure the distance so that a parasol does not come into contact with the heat source or naked flame if it accidentally topples or is knocked down.
- The parasol is designed for use in light winds up to wind force 3. Close the parasol at higher wind forces, or if there are gusts of wind or other weather conditions such as rainfall.

- ▶ Place bottom pole into parasol stand and secure in the parasol stand



- ▶ Place parasol in the lower pole
- ▶ Secure parasol with locking device

5 Opening


You can open the parasol by spreading it out.



- ▶ Keep parasol away from you, press catch and push slider upwards. The parasol spreads out and the slider engages in the upper position.

6 Align

You can align the parasol to face the sun.




- ▶ Push up sleeve
- ▶ Bend parasol in hinge direction
- ▶ Secure parasol with sleeve

Align parasol in a straight line again:

- ▶ Push up sleeve
- ▶ Align parasol in a straight line
- ▶ Push sleeve down

7 Closing

You can close the parasol mechanically.



- ▶ Align parasol in a straight line
- ▶ Press catch and push slider down
- ▶ Secure parasol with fastening strap

8 Storage

You should store the parasol in a dry and safe location.

Tips

- Leave the parasol open to dry if wet.
- You can store the dry parasol closed and secured with fastening strap in the carrying case.
